10 Hebrew Words Every Christian Should Know

The Old Testament was written in ancient Hebrew and Aramaic. The New Testament was written in Greek. Yet, thanks to the work of many translators over the centuries, the inspired words of the Bible have been conveyed into English for us. Thus, it isn't necessary to be literate in ancient Hebrew, Aramaic, or Greek in order to read and comprehend the Scriptures. What a blessing! However, studying the meaning and usage of the original Hebrew words can still be of great benefit for a Christian by deepening one's understanding of the language God chose to use. Here are ten Hebrew words every Christian should know:

- **1. ADONAI** means "Lord, or master." When used by a human being toward the Creator, it indicates complete submission to and recognition of God's supreme authority. It is the word Moses used to refer to God (Exodus 4:10). See also Deuteronomy 10:17 and Psalm 71:16.
- **2. AHAVA** / **AHAB** means "to love dearly" and often points to an intense emotional bond, or strong connection. *Ahava* is a word used to describe the kind of love God has for us (Hosea 14:4) and the kind of love we must have toward Him (Deuteronomy 6:5). When the Old Testament was translated into the Greek language for the Septuagint (LXX), this word was rendered as "agape." It is the strongest word for love in that vernacular, describing an unconditional love.



- **3. AMEN** literally means "so be it." Did you know that it was a Hebrew word? You are speaking Hebrew when you use it to affirm something someone says. By saying "amen," we're stating that
- we agree with what has been said, we believe it, or find it true. Amen is also sometimes translated as "truth," in Isaiah 65:16.
- **4. ELOHIM** is primarily translated as "God" (2,346 times in the KJV!), but is sometimes translated as "god or gods" (as in false gods), or "judges, mighty, and angels." Context determines its correct usage. It is the plural form of the word *El* or *Eloah* ("Mighty One") and is the first name used for God in the Bible (Gen 1:1). It indicates the plurality of the Father, Son, and Spirit.
- **5. HESED (Chesed)** can be translated as "favor, mercy, love, loving-kindness, or unfailing love." These are all characteristics that are attributed to God and are also the actions that flow from His great love. However, depending on the context, correctly translating this word can prove to be a little difficult. See Gen 39:21; Psalm 63:3; Micah 6:8; and Hosea 6:6 for examples.
- **6. HALLELU JAH** is made up of the words *halal* and *jah*. The word *halal* means "to praise, shine, or to be boastful," and other similar terms. *Jah* or *Yahh* is short for the name of God in the Bible, Yahweh. So, *hallelujah* literally means "to praise God, make Him shine; to boast in Him!" This word is still useful for us in our modern worship and praise to the Father let's use it more!
- 7. MASHIACH if there were just one Hebrew word every Christian should know, it should be Meshiach. It means "saving or anointed one." Jesus, the Christ, is our Meshiach (Messiah) as He is the anointed one of God and it is He that saves us. Daniel 9:25 says, "Know and understand this: From the time the word goes out to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until the Anointed One (Mashiach), the ruler, comes, ... " The word "Christ" is the Anglicized Greek form of the Hebrew word Meshiach, or Messiah.
- **8. SHALOM** means "peace," but the biblical concept of the word involves much more. It is not merely the absence of conflict; but rather, encapsulates "wholeness, wellness, peace, security, welfare, prosperity" and even more meanings! For example, the Lord Himself is *shalom* (Judges 6:24), and He blesses his people with *shalom* (Psalm 29:11). Even for Christians, this is what Jesus offers to us as the Prince of *Shalom* (Isaiah 9:6). *Shalom* is still used as a standard greeting in modern Hebrew language.
- **9. YAHWEH** is the proper name for God (used 6,528 times in the Old Testament). It is often rendered in capitalized letters as, "LORD," and means "self Existent or eternal One." It is derived from *Yahh* (*Jah*), the sacred name for the "God of Israel," and the Hebrew letters YHWH, as seen in "I Am That I Am" (cf. Ex 3:14). It is frequently written as "LORD God" (*Yahweh Elohim*).
- 10. YESHUA is used throughout the Hebrew scriptures, meaning "salvation." It was derived from the Hebrew word *yasha*, which means "to deliver" or "to rescue." It is translated into English as "Joshua." When translated from Greek to English in the New Testament, it underwent a few transitions and eventually became "Jesus." One great example of the word is found in Exodus 15:2, "The Lord is my strength and song, And He has become my salvation [*yeshua*]," and also, "He only is my rock and my salvation [*yeshua*], My stronghold; I shall not be greatly shaken." (Psalm 62:2)
