

THE EXCEPTION OR THE RULE?

We live in a society that glorifies individualism and the unconventional, so the temptation to seek out the exception rather than adhere to the rule is quite prevalent in our thinking. Stories of mavericks going against the grain captivate us, making the pursuit of exceptionalism seem to be the most desirable and acceptable. This is especially true with religion. It seems that shunning the "old paths" (Jeremiah 6:16) and forging an avant-garde or "more spiritual way to love God" is preferred. However, when it comes to the Bible, choosing the exception to the rule is not always a wise choice. The exception does not override the rule; but instead, emphasizes its importance!



In my ministry, many approach me or contact me to ask what the Bible teaches about a particular topic. Quite often, no sooner do I finish giving them a sound, Bible answer, that I immediately hear, "But what about...?" It is a troubling and increasingly reoccurring pattern - always eager to find an exception to the rule. This is not a new problem. During the time of Jesus, the Pharisees built an elaborate system of man-made rules and regulations around God's law to "protect it" from what they perceived as lawless abuse. Ironically, by adding to God's commands, they essentially did away with it! By insisting on upholding their for themselves they were "making the word of God of no effect"! (Mark 7:13)

Another example is the lawyer in Luke 10:29. By asking Jesus, "Who is my neighbor?" he was essentially, looking for a loophole in the law of God. He had no issue with loving God, but he did not want to love someone whom he did not have to love. He wasn't focused on submitting to or doing God's will, but rather doing just the minimum! He was trying to find an exception to the rule of "love thy neighbor as thyself" (Leviticus 19:18; Matthew 22:37-39).

A modern example is how many will appeal to the thief on the cross (Luke 23:39-43) as the exception to being immersed, thereby making the "rule" for baptism not required for salvation. Even if we completely ignore the fact that (a) they're assuming the man wasn't baptized, (b) he was still under the old law, because Jesus hadn't died yet, and (c) Jesus has the power to forgive sins in person, (Luke 5:20) it by no means removes the command to be baptized (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38, 10:48, 22:16). Why didn't the 3000 on Pentecost, the Ethiopian eunuch, or Paul himself claim the "exception to the rule" by appealing to the thief on the cross? It is because the exception does not override the rule. Baptism being necessary for salvation is NOT some ambiguous option. It is required by God's will.

There is no end to the "exceptions to the rule" that people look for in the Bible. They seek exceptions to the worship pattern that is clearly laid out in Scripture (John 4:24; Acts 2:42, 20:7; 1 Cor 11:23-28, 14:40, 16:2; Col 3:16). They hunt for exceptions in church leadership (Acts 20:28; 1 Cor 14:34; 1 Tim 2:12, 3:1-13). They even appeal to "exceptions" in the authority of Scripture itself (Matt 7:21-23, 28:18; 2 Tim 3:16-17; 2 Pet 1:3, 20-21; Rev 22:18-19)! Yet, the Bible states clearly, "Hold fast the pattern of sound words which you have heard from me, in faith and love which are in Christ Jesus." (2 Tim 1:13) And, "But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine [pattern] to which you were delivered." (Rom 6:17) Over and over, we see that God is a God of pattern, consistency, and exactitude. Yes, His grace and mercy are a free gift, but that doesn't mean we can abuse it by always looking for an exception (cf. Romans 6:1-23). He requires submission to His will - His "rules" (John 14:15; Jas 4:7).

Sometimes there may be an exception to a rule. But choosing the exception to the rule is not always a wise choice. In any case, the exception never becomes the rule in the Bible. Perhaps the most troubling aspect of all of this is that it is a heart issue. God's commandments are not burdensome (1 John 5:3) so why not just do what He says to do?
