What It Means to Fear the Lord

Many people have a somewhat skewed, or incorrect view of God. Our Creator is often portrayed or thought of as some angry, jealous policeman sitting up in heaven just waiting for us to make a mistake so that He can strike us down with fire or lightning. Yes, we read that He loves us. Still, the Bible also says, "For I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God" (Exodus 20:5), "O LORD God, to whom vengeance belongs" (Psalm 94:1), and "It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God" (Hebrews 10:31). In fact, we are commanded, "Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, For this is man's all" (Ecclesiastes 12:13). Indeed, it sounds as if Yahweh may be a bit hostile, ill-tempered, and vindictive. So, is that true? What does it mean to "fear" the Lord?

First, it is not true that God is some moody, envious law enforcer just waiting for us to mess up. That is not His character. Instead, the Bible describes God as "love" (1 John 4:8), "merciful and forgiving" (Daniel 9:9; Luke 6:36), and "the LORD is good" (Psalm 34:8). We should also remember that "God is not a man, that He should lie, Nor a son of man, that He should repent. Has He said, and will He not do? Or has He spoken, and will He not make it good?" (Numbers 23:19)

So how do we reconcile those verses with the ones that talk about His "vengeance and wrath" (Nahum 1:2)? Perhaps it would help to think of a judge who is over a court of law. The



judge is simply a human being with authority according to the law. If a criminal stands before him and is pronounced guilty for the crime that he committed, how might the offender view the judge? He will probably see him as angry, wrathful, or "unfair" because he didn't rule in the way the criminal wanted. But the character of the judge himself may simply be a kind, gentle person who is just doing his job. He may actually care for the offender, but at the same time, he must carry out justice according to the law. That is similar to how we can understand God's character.

God's wrath, vengeance, or jealousy are all based on our behavior toward Him, not Who He is. His character is pure and as Exodus 34:6-7 says, He is "a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness, keeping steadfast love for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, but who will by no means clear the guilty ..." And, Psalm 7:11, "God is a just judge." God's true nature is that of love, not indignation.

Secondly, the word "fear," in the many verses that associate it with our relationship to God, can also be translated as "revere, stand in awe, show reverence, give respect or honor to." It certainly carries the idea of being afraid, even terrified of the Almighty (Gen 3:10; Ex 19:16-17; Psalm 114:7), but also implies a healthy respect and admiration for His sovereignty. We might make a comparison between an earthly father to our Heavenly Father. A father obviously loves his child, unconditionally, and wants to provide for and protect the child. Yet, he also wants the child to respect him as the parent and as the authority figure in the relationship. It's the same with Yahweh, our loving God. "God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, And to be held in reverence by all those around Him." (Psalm 89:7).

God's children should certainly not be afraid of Him. We have no reason to be afraid. The Lord has given us the promise that nothing can separate us from His love (Romans 8:38-39), and that He will never leave us, nor forsake us (Hebrews 13:5). So, "fearing God" simply means having a deep reverence for Him. Such understanding should impact the way we live. To fear God means respecting Him, obeying by submitting to His will, and worshiping Him in spirit and truth. "God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind," (2 Tim 1:7)

The only ones who should be afraid of or tremble at God are those who are disobedient to His will. Every human being that has ever lived, is living, or will live shall stand before the throne (Rev 20:12-15). When Jesus returns, God will "take vengeance on those who do not know Him" (2 Thess 1:8). That is certainly a different kind of fear!
