Apologetics Press Discovery Bible Cards!

A couple of weeks ago, we introduced, **Discovery Bible Cards** to our Kingdom Kids. Everyone (including some of our Youth Group) seemed to love this new, exciting, engaging, and educational way to learn more about God’s Word! Each of these durable, high-quality cards features either a person, an event, or some other kind of key moment from the Bible. The back of each card has several important "facts" and Scripture about the Bible person, event, or moment.

- There are 365 cards in the entire set, and the cards are divided into 18 different “series” that organize the cards into collectible “sets within the set.”
- Within the set of 365 cards are 20 “premium cards” that are more “rare.” These cards are not more “important,” but they are coated with a special finish that gives them a “shiny” look and will be fun to collect. Be on the lookout for these “premium cards” as you collect your Discovery Bible Cards!
- Each week we will be giving out new cards! **Each of our elders will have cards available** - all you have to do is go to one of them and ask for a card. But, be ready, they may ask you a question before just handing out the card!
- Youth Group: you will be asked to tell something (anything) about who or what is on the card! Be ready!
- Soon, we will also be making prizes available to the Kingdom Kids who have collected a certain number of cards, can answer questions about their cards, or some other fun way to earn a board game, a devotional book, and more!



Discovery Bible Cards can be used in a variety of ways!

Discovery Bible Cards can be enjoyed by all ages, and can be an exciting learning opportunity for children, teens, adults, families, and the entire church. We encourage everyone to collect and trade them with friends and family. Put them in binders, or special card holders, as you build your collection.

Here are a few recommendations for using the cards. Use them for personal Bible study, or as a home/family Bible study tool or devotional topic starter. Use them also as bookmarks, flash cards, or even as a tool for evangelism! Teachers can use them as a Bible class resource, or as prizes/rewards for children/teens for special occasions. Teachers, there are also packs available that contain an entire series, like the Apostles, etc. which can be useful for class topics.

Here are a few games that have been suggested by others who are using Discovery Bible Cards in their church:

- “OLD OR NEW?” Show the front of the card and ask if the person is in the Old or New Testament. Give one point for each correct answer. The student with the most points wins a trading card (or a pack of cards).
- “WHO AM I?” Separate students into teams. Take a card from the set and begin reading the “Fast Facts” on the back, one at a time. The team who guesses the name on the card first wins the card. The most cards wins.
- “COMMON CARDS” Show multiple cards connected by a common person, place, event, etc. The person/team who can tell you the common person, place, event, etc. gets a point. Example: Show “The Burning Bush,” “Pharaoh,” and “The Bronze Serpent.” The “common card” would be “Moses.”

These are just a few of the ideas that have been suggested and used by others, but the possibilities are really only limited by how big your imagination might be! We hope Discovery Bible Cards will help many learn more Scripture!
